Eileen Sobjack

Eileen Sobjack was elected president of the National Federation of Republican Women (NFRW) at the 41st Biennial Convention in Orlando, Fla., and took office in January 2022.

Previously, Eileen served on the NFRW Executive Committee as 1st vice president, 2nd vice president, 3rd vice president, secretary and member-at-large. She is an NFRW Capitol Regent. In 2011, she was one of five state presidents nominated for the NFRW Ronald Reagan Leadership Award.

At the state level, she served in many key and varied roles before being elected to two terms as state president of the Washington Federation of Republican Women (WFRW). During her terms WFRW membership increased.

Eileen was elected as a Whatcom County charter review commissioner in 2015, receiving the most votes in her district. She is a lifetime member of the VFW Auxiliary, served as a trustee in her church and is a former public school teacher and private teaching consultant. She and her husband raised three active responsible citizens who, along with their spouses and nine children, are all Republicans.



Todd Myers

Todd Myers is the Director of the Center for the Environment at Washington Policy Center. He is one of the nation's leading experts on free-market environmental policy. Todd is the author of the landmark 2011 book *Eco-Fads: How the Rise of Trendy Environmentalism Is Harming the Environment* and was a Wall Street Journal Expert Panelist for energy and the environment. He has authored numerous studies on environmental issues, including *Five Years of Environmental Policy: Are We Making a Difference*; *Promoting Personal Choice, Incentives and Investment to Cut Greenhouse Gases*, and more.



Brad Dacus, Esq. – President and Founder Pacific Justice Institute

Brad Dacus served as Legislative Assistant to U.S. Senator Phil Gramm, and went on to receive his Juris Doctor from the *University of Texas, School of Law*. Brad coordinated religious freedom and parental rights cases throughout the Western States for five years prior to founding *Pacific Justice Institute* in 1997. PJI handles more case matters—always free of charge—defending faith and family coast to coast more than any other organization of its kind with hundreds of volunteer attorneys.

Brad Dacus can be watched daily (M-TH) on Brad Dacus Live on Hischannel.com and heard weekly on *The Dacus Report* on more than 800 radio stations across the country and also as a guest speaker on numerous radio and television programs across the nation. He has appeared on *America Live, CBS Evening News, CNN, Dateline NBC, Good Morning America, MSNBC, NBC News, News Talk TV, and The Today Show* and numerous times on *FOX News*.

Mr. Dacus' varied public speaking opportunities include public debate and testifying before the United States House of Representatives in Washington, D.C. He has also testified numerous times before the California State Legislature on legislation affecting religious freedom and parents' rights. Mr. Dacus continues to speak regularly at churches, conferences, graduations and conventions throughout the United States and was presented an honorary Doctorate of Religious Freedom and Family Rights degree from *California Baptist University* in recognition of his commitment to faith and justice and his work protecting parental rights and religious freedom through the *Pacific Justice Institute*.



Glen Morgan

Glen founded We the Governed in 2016. He is currently the volunteer Executive Director for the Citizens Alliance for Property Rights. Glen Morgan was the Grassroots Director and the Property Rights Director at the Freedom Foundation 2011-2015. He enjoys creating videos documenting Big Government's abuses of citizens – particularly on property rights issues.

Glen helped launch the Washington Voter Research Project, a Washington State non-profit organization that helps concerned volunteer activists canvass Washington State's voter rolls and help local auditors clean up problematic and sloppy voter rolls. He has repeatedly been attacked by the corporate media, angry politicians, and the Democratic Party for daring to look at elections, a project he has been involved in long before Trump decided to run for public office.



Bill Bruch

Bill Bruch is serving his 6th year and 3rd elected term as Chairman of the Skagit County Republican Party. He is a former La Conner Town Council Member, owns his own business and is a longtime property manager.

Bill is also the Washington State Republican Party Election Integrity Chairman and serves on the WSRP State Committee Executive Board. The Committee includes 22 committed members from many of our state's counties.
