Only clubs that have paid their annual service charge and full membership per-capita dues for both 2016 and 2017 are considered eligible for the Achievement Awards, unless chartered late in 2016 or in 2017. Women club members are considered in good standing if they have paid their 2017 dues to NFRW through their club.
