It is important to learn and incorporate these guidelines into your club's planning and operations because the public is watching where candidates receive money! In fact a WFRW Club was just cited last year by the PDC for providing direct candidate support (DCS). This could happen to your club if you do not follow the guidelines. PDC violations may result in probation or a monetary fine in the thousands. Play it safe and contribute to your county party or LD, rather than providing DCS. Remember individuals can always provide DCS without any issues.
